**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE-** NDSU student-run organization ThunderRadio and the Fargo Theatre will celebrate its first live broadcast on their new station KNDS 105.9 FM 11:00 am Monday, Oct. 11, 2004, at 1233 N University Dr. Fargo. West Fargo Mayor Richard Mattern and NDSU President Joseph Chapman along with other local dignitaries will attend the station launch. KNDS 105.9 is a joint venture between ThunderRadio and the Fargo Theatre.

ThunderRadio has been streaming music, sports, and news over the Internet since the fall of 1999. A process over three years in the making, the FCC has granted a low power FM license allowing ThunderRadio and the Fargo Theatre to broadcast throughout the Fargo-Moorhead community.

With over 80 members, ThunderRadio creates “the rumble in your radio”. It boasts a spectrum of entertainment: a variety of music, morning talk shows, political forums, coverage of local and national news, and live broadcasts of NDSU athletics.

ThunderRadio General Manager Matt Langemo is very excited about the progressive step ThunderRadio has taken in the last year. “With the team of officers we have, I think we have a good mix of leadership, experience, and dedication. Our entire team is excited to make ThunderRadio a success for the student body and the Fargo-Moorhead community.”
